All services are free and available to residents and businesses affected by the Colorado Floods.

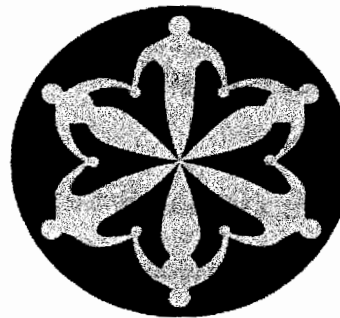
How do I get flood debris removed from my property?

Larimer County residents who need help cleaning their homes and/or removing flood debris can call for assistance. Many non-profit organizations from across the United States have volunteered to help with flood clean-up and recovery.

United Way 2-1-1 will serve as the central registration point for clean-up assistance. Residents can register in-person or over the phone.

To register over the phone dial 2-1-1 or 970-407-7066 between 7:30am to 5:30pm and asked to be placed on the flood clean-up list.

Long Term Recovery Group and Crisis Clean-up: LTRG is creating a priority list to help survivors with debris clean-up and removal. Please contact the LTRG in Loveland to register as well as 2-1-1 Crisis Clean-up.
